# Congratulations on your upcoming wedding!

The Catholic Church speaks of the loving and sacred purpose of marriage:

"Since God created him man and woman, their mutual love becomes an image of the absolute and unfailing love with which God loves all."

We realize that you have many tasks to complete to prepare for your wedding, so this guide is to help you choose your music.

## Here is what you need to do:

- 1. Read this guide.
- 2. Enter your desired music on the *Wedding Music Selection Form*. (Available on Church website)
- 3. Give your payments for the organist (\$250) and cantor (\$150) to the wedding coordinator at your rehearsal. However, if your wedding has been paid for with *the "all inclusive" plan*, you do not need to pay the musicians separately.

# Some FAQ

- Generally, music for the Wedding Liturgy is of a *sacred nature*, and the words of hymns should *address God and be of a sacred nature*. If you have questions about music you would like to have included, contact Dr. Gregory Hamilton, via e-mail (see below).
- For your music, you will need at least an *organist* and a *cantor*.
- Dr. Hamilton plays for all weddings at St. Joseph as organist, unless he appoints a substitute.
- All weddings must have a St. Joseph Cantor... our members of the Cantor Guild, are highly dedicated, skilled, and sing all year round at every parish mass as volunteers. Having a St. Joseph cantor at your wedding ENSURES that the liturgy and music will be sung beautifully. Although not primary, Income is a consideration. The income from weddings is a traditional part of the income of the parish cantors and music director/organist.
- However, we do allow a visiting singer to sing one or two selections during the mass, subject to approval from the music director.
- We allow and can certainly help procure, trumpet players, woodwinds etc.
- We can provide a choir if desired for an additional cost.

We are committed to providing a beautiful Liturgy for your wedding, and remind you, that we are here to help in any way for your wedding preparation.
