MASS JOURNALING

Consider helping your child JOURNAL about the weekend's Mass Readings or about what they see & hear during Mass. They could do so before Mass to prepare, during Mass to follow along, or after Mass for follow-up & discussion.

Primary Journals are blank composition books for younger children combining both drawing and writing space.

Start with a wide-ruled Composition Book—ask June for a directions page to paste inside!

Bring a writing utensil and/or color pencils or crayons (plus something stiff to write on) so your elementary child can complete a St. Joseph Church My Mass Journal page (double-sided) to connect more closely with Mass each weekend!
