2/1/2026 Candlemas Pancakes - In 2026, Candlemas, also known as the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, will be celebrated on Monday, February 2nd. It's a Christian holiday commemorating the presentation of the infant Jesus at the Temple in Jerusalem, and the purification of the Virgin Mary, 40 days after his birth. A key tradition is the blessing of candles, symbolizing Jesus as the light of the world, which are then used throughout the year in homes and churches.
